ORDINANCE 25-07

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF ROYAL CITY, WASHINGTON, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2026

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Royal City, Washington, completed and placed on file with the City Finance Director a proposed budget and estimate of the amount of the moneys required to meet the public expenses, reserve funds and expenses of government of said city for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2026, and a notice was published that the Council of said city would meet on the 18th day of November, 2025, at 7:00 pm, at the council chambers in the City Hall of said city for the purpose of making and adopting a budget for said fiscal year and giving taxpayers within the limits of said city an opportunity to be heard upon said budget; and

WHEREAS, the said City Council did meet at said time and place and did then consider the matter of said proposed budget; and

WHEREAS, the said proposed budget does not exceed the lawful limit of taxation allowed by law to be levied on the property within the City of Royal City for the purposes set forth in said budget, and the estimated expenditures set forth in said budget being all necessary to carry on the government of said city for said year and being sufficient to meet the various needs of said city during said period.

NOW, THEREFORE the City Council of the City of Royal City do ordain as follows:

- **Section 1:** That the budget for the City of Royal City, Washington, for the year 2026 is hereby adopted at the fund level in its final form and content as set forth in the document entitled City of Royal City 2026 Annual Budget, three copies of which are on file in the Office of the City Finance Director.
- Section 2: Estimated resources for each separate fund of the City of Royal City, and aggregate expenditures for all such funds for the year 2026 are set forth in a summary form below and are hereby appropriated for expenditure at the fund level during the year 2026 as set forth in the City of Royal City 2026 Annual Budget.
